### REPORTING RELATIONSHIPS AND WORK ENVIRONMENT:

The Bicycle Coalition of Greater Philadelphia runs on an operating budget of \$1.4 Million. The Development Associate will report to the Director of Development and serve as a member of the Development Team. This position will solicit corporations for membership and event sponsorship, stewarding current corporate donors, and prospecting and cultivation. In addition this individual will be responsible for fulfilling sponsor benefits and soliciting in-kind support for our programs and events.

#### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

The Development Associate will:

 Coordinate and assist with corporate sponsorship prospecting, strategy, and engagement. This person will need to be able to convey our mission and the need to support our work to new audiences.



- Solicit corporate sponsors for financial and product support through phone calls, in person meetings, print and social media. Tender proposals and close on opportunities.
- Gift administration track, file contact reports, and fulfill deliverables. Update our corporate pipelines, assist in reporting and prospect research.
- Perform general office duties, attend meetings, assist with appointments and calendars.
- Assist in developing fundraising strategies for BCGP's programs.
- Assist with live tabling throughout the year. Assist with rides, social and sponsored.
- Work with development team and take lead on specific events. Develop strategies to enhance return on investment and participation at our existing events and partnerships.
- Deliver exceptional sponsor experiences and satisfaction.
